WHO'S ELIGIBLE

- Entrants may compete in the student competition if at least one student is on the team (in a substantial role such as a founder, not an intern); AND that student is currently enrolled at The University of Alabama, or that student graduated from The University of Alabama within the past 12 months. If both of these criteria are met, it is okay to have non-student members on the team and still compete.
- Previous grand prize winners are unable to compete for the same idea again.
- Previous competitors (including 1st-prize and below) can compete with the same idea as long as they've made significant progress since the last year.
- A team can only compete in one of our Spring competitions.
