Program Highlight

Teams with **student Entrepreneurial Leads (ELs)** and a **Technical Advisor (TA)** will be formed, the commercialization ideas will be generated, validated, and tested through the 3-phase program. The proposed commercialization path (startup or licensing) will be pitched to judges and receive feedback and prizes.

Each team will be paired with a coach. • At the end of the Crimson Startup, judges will pick top 3 teams from qualified teams. <p>** Qualified teams are the ones that participate in the whole 6-week crimson startup and conduct at least 50 customer interviews.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The top 3 qualified teams will receive awards (\$3,000, \$2,000, and \$1,000)* • All the other qualified teams will receive \$600* as a recognition for completing Crimson Startup • All the qualified teams can move to Phase 3. <p><i>* Cash prizes are for ELs only.</i></p>
<p>Phase 3</p> <p>R, 11/17/22 6-9pm</p>	<p>Final Business Pitches and Plan for Moving Forward</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All the qualified teams are eligible for joining the final pitch. • On Thursday, 11/17/22 at 6pm, the teams will pitch to judges, receive awards, and follow-up with the leadership team to plan moving forward 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Awards (\$10,000, \$7,000, \$4,000)** will be conditionally given to the top 3 teams • More support is available for the teams that plan on moving forward with a business. <p><i>**condition: each winning team EL can receive up to \$1,000 cash, the rest will be saved in an account for business development)</i></p>
